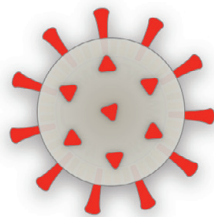


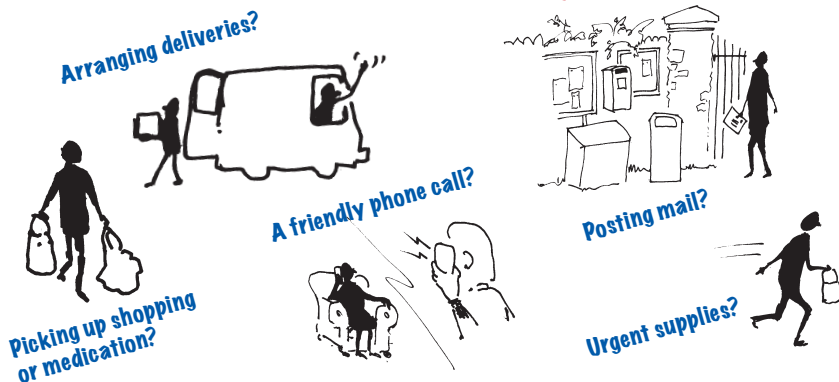
Community Response to Coronavirus
