

Welcome to Harberton Parish Hall

Once again this versatile space is transformed into a theatre to delight you with all the fun of the village panto. Sit back and enjoy it and do join in loudly in appropriate places.

This year the Hall is proud to support the newly formed Pantomime Committee who hope to be self financing after this performance.

The Hall is available for hire for a

wide range of events with special rates for village users.

It can provide for 100 guests at a wedding reception, it can accommodate a bouncy castle for a children's party, it has a semi-sprung floor suitable for dance events and ideal for children's play, it can seat 200 for a concert or can be hired by just 2 for a game of badminton. The small meeting room can be hired on its own for a small charge. We can provide cutlery, crockery, coloured lights, bunting and some children's play equipment.

These regular (mostly term time) public activities generate the basic income for the day to day running of the Hall.

You may have noticed money being spent on things like new chairs, new steps, new handrails etc., this spending has only been possible as a result of *extra fundraising activities*, primarily the ongoing series of major folk concerts which are

becoming well-known over the whole of South Devon and

beyond.

But other shows, such as "Villages in Action" events, which are heavily subsidised by Devon county to bring top-class entertainment to rural communities, are organised from time to time. And it is these events where we are looking for more local support. Audiences have been disappointingly small at some shows - while the performances have merited far more.

You will find a flyer detailing forthcoming events inside this programme, and all events will be advertised by posters round the village and in the Parish Magazine as the time approaches. We need to build large new storage cupboards at the Hall, we need to install an air-conditioning system, and there are other projects on the drawing board. But we need your support for events put on at the Hall to allow these projects to happen.


